WHAT IS FAMILY PLANNING?

Family planning, according to the World Health Organization (WHO), is the ability of individuals and couples to anticipate and attain their desired number of children, which includes the spacing and timing of births and a woman's right to decide if she wants to have children or not.

Family planning is a strategic investment point for sustainable development, empowering women, improving health and well-being, and fostering economic growth.

It is recognized as a strategic "best buy" for development, with the potential to expedite progress across the five themes of the Sustainable Development Goals: People, Planet, Prosperity, Peace, and Partnership.
